

## **Always Read** The Label

The label provides information on how to safely use the product.

Avoid contact with eyes, skin, or clothing. Wear safety glasses or protective eye wear and rubber gloves when handling product

product.



**Always Wear** Required Personal **Protective** Equipment!

Wear safety glasses or goggles, chemical-resistant gloves, and work clothes.\*



**Never Store Pesticides** in a Food or Beverage Container



\* Specific personal protective equipment (PPE) must be worn as indicated on the product label.

## What is a Pesticide?

A pesticide is any substance intended to control, destroy, repel, or attract a pest, and includes insecticides, fungicides, herbicides, rodenticides and sanitizers.
