TO: DEPARTMENT OF PESTICIDE REGULATION INDIVIDUAL AND BUSINESS LICENSEES

SUBJECT: NEW LICENSE NUMBERS FOR RENEWAL APPLICANTS

The Department of Pesticide Regulation's enhanced licensing database requires that we issue different license numbers. If your name begins with A through L, you will receive a new license number when you renew your license later this year. If your name begins with M through Z, you will receive a new license number when you renew your license in late 2009. (If you received a *new* pest control business or individual license after August 2007, you already have the new five to six digit license number.)

By mid-August, the Department of Pesticide Regulation will have notified all A through L renewal applicants by mail of this license number change. In addition, the license packet you receive in early September will have your new license number.

**Individual and Business license abbreviations**

These abbreviations for individual and business licenses are on your new license number.
