NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF
HUMAN HEALTH RISK ASSESSMENT
FOR THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT
1,3-DICHLOROPROPENE

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) has completed a risk assessment for the active ingredient 1,3-dichloropropene (1,3-D). The purpose of this risk assessment is to evaluate potential human health risks to workers, occupational and residential bystanders, and the general public from 1,3-D inhalation exposure scenarios. The final risk characterization document (RCD) is available at <<http://www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/risk/rcd.htm>>.

DPR will issue a risk management directive (RMD) if there are exposure scenarios of concern identified by the RCD that requires mitigation. If an RMD is issued, a public notice with a link to the RMD will be released and posted on DPR's Web site at <<http://www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/registration/canot/camenu.htm>>.

Since new uses or discoveries concerning the active ingredient may change the risk potential at any time, the RCD may be subject to revisions in the future to account for any new information or data that DPR determines will impact the risk assessment.
