NOTICE OF COMPLETION OF
RISK CHARACTERIZATION DOCUMENT
FOR THE ACTIVE INGREDIENT
PROPANIL

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) has completed the risk characterization document (RCD) for the active ingredient propanil. The final RCD is available at <http://www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/whs/active_ingredient/propanil.htm> under the “Risk Assessment Documents” tab.

DPR will issue a risk management directive (RMD) if there are exposure scenarios of concern identified by the RCD that require mitigation. If DPR issues an RMD, it will be available at <http://www.cdpr.ca.gov/docs/whs/active_ingredient/propanil.htm> under the “Mitigation Documents” tab.

Since new uses or discoveries concerning the active ingredient may change the risk potential at any time, the RCD may be subject to revisions in the future to account for any new information or data that DPR determines will impact the risk assessment.
