NOTICE OF PROPOSED EMERGENCY ACTION

LICENSING AND CERTIFICATION FEES

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) proposes to amend sections 6502 and 6505 of Title 3, California Code of Regulations relating to license and certificate application, renewal, and exam fees. DPR also proposes to amend the following forms, incorporated by reference in section 6502, to reflect the new fees and make nonsubstantive changes: Qualified Applicator License Application LIC-001 (Rev. 07/23), Qualified Applicator Certificate Application LIC-001A (Rev. 07/23), Pest Control Business License Application LIC-042 (Rev. 07/23), Agricultural Pest Control Adviser Application LIC-084 (Rev. 07/23), Pest Control Aircraft Pilot Certificate Application LIC-005 (Rev. 07/23), Pest Control Dealer Designated Agent License Application LIC-043 (Rev. 07/23), Pest Control Business Renewal Application LIC-192 (Rev. 07/23), Individual License/Certificate Renewal Application LIC-141 (Rev. 07/23), Maintenance Gardener Pest Control Business License Application DPR-PML-004 (Rev. 10/18), Maintenance Gardener Pest Control Business Renewal Application DPR-PML-186 (Rev. 04/18), Pest Control Dealer License Application DPR-PML-041 (Rev. 10/18), Pest Control Dealer License Renewal Application DPR-PML-191 (Rev. 04/18), Pesticide Broker License Application DPR-PML-217 (Rev. 10/18), Pesticide Broker License Renewal Application DPR-PML-190 (Rev. 04/18). Attached to this Notice is the specific regulatory language of DPR's proposed emergency action and Finding of Emergency. Government Code section 11346.1(a)(2) requires that, at least five working days prior to submission of the proposed emergency action to the Office of Administrative Law (OAL), the adopting agency provide a notice of the proposed emergency action to every person who has filed a request for notice of regulatory action with the agency. After submission of the proposed emergency to OAL, OAL shall allow interested persons five calendar days to submit comments on the proposed emergency regulations as set forth in Government Code section 11349.6. Any interested person may submit comments in writing relevant to the proposed emergency action via U.S. mail, e-mail, or facsimile. Written comments must be received at OAL and at DPR simultaneously, within five calendar days after DPR submits the emergency regulation to OAL for review. Please address comments to:

Upon filing, OAL will have ten calendar days within which to review and make a decision on the proposed emergency rule. If approved, OAL will file the regulations with the Secretary of State, and the emergency regulations will become effective on August 5, 2024.
