

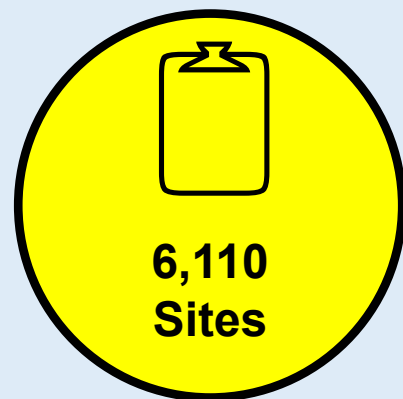
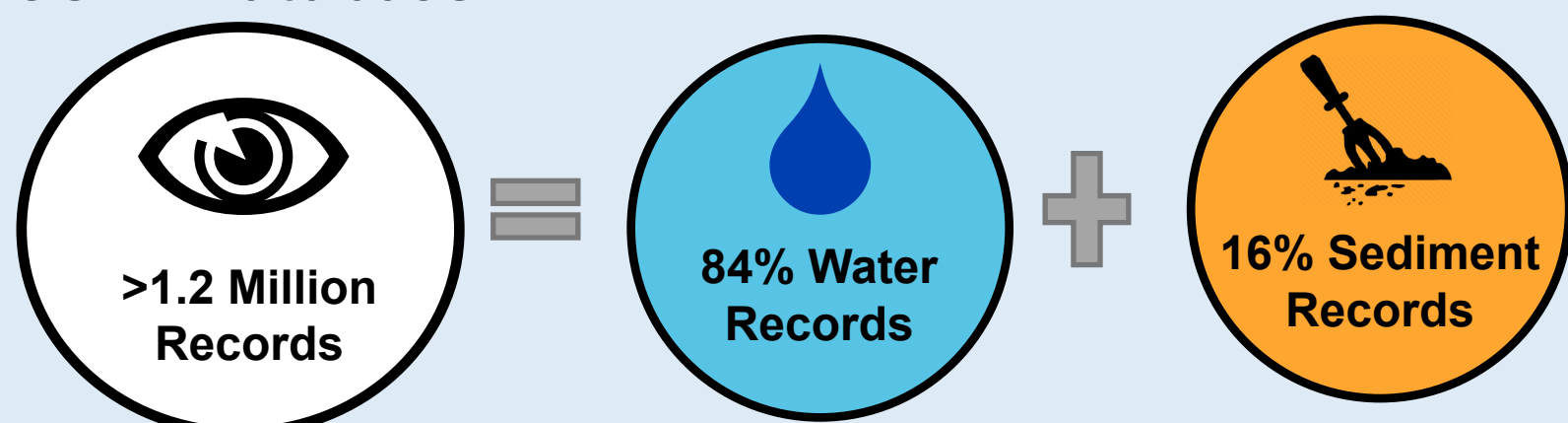


Surface Water Database (SURF)

Highlights of the 2023 SURF Update

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) maintains a Surface Water Database (SURF) containing data from a wide variety of environmental monitoring studies designed to test for the presence or absence of pesticides in California surface waters. 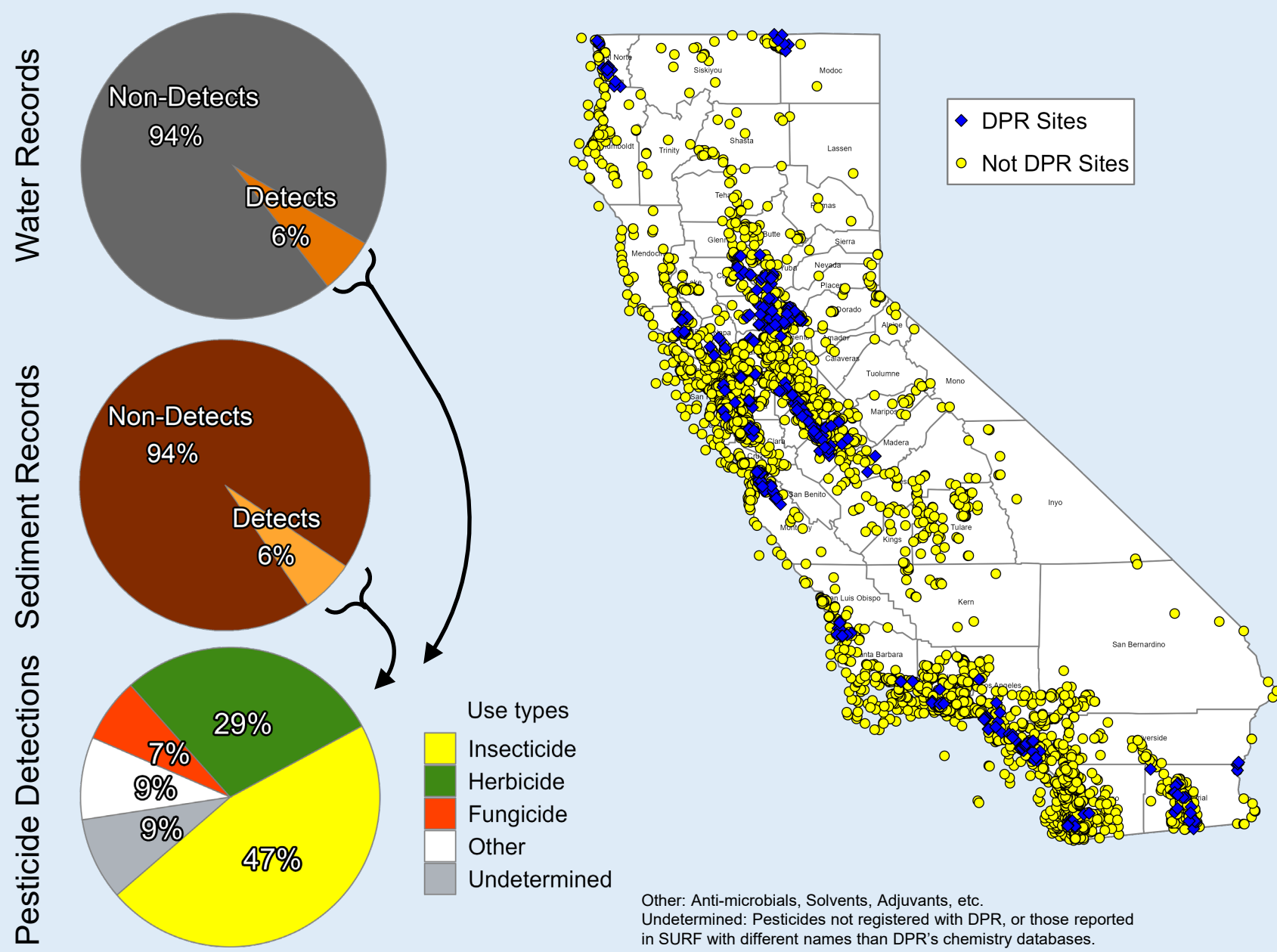
SURF Database



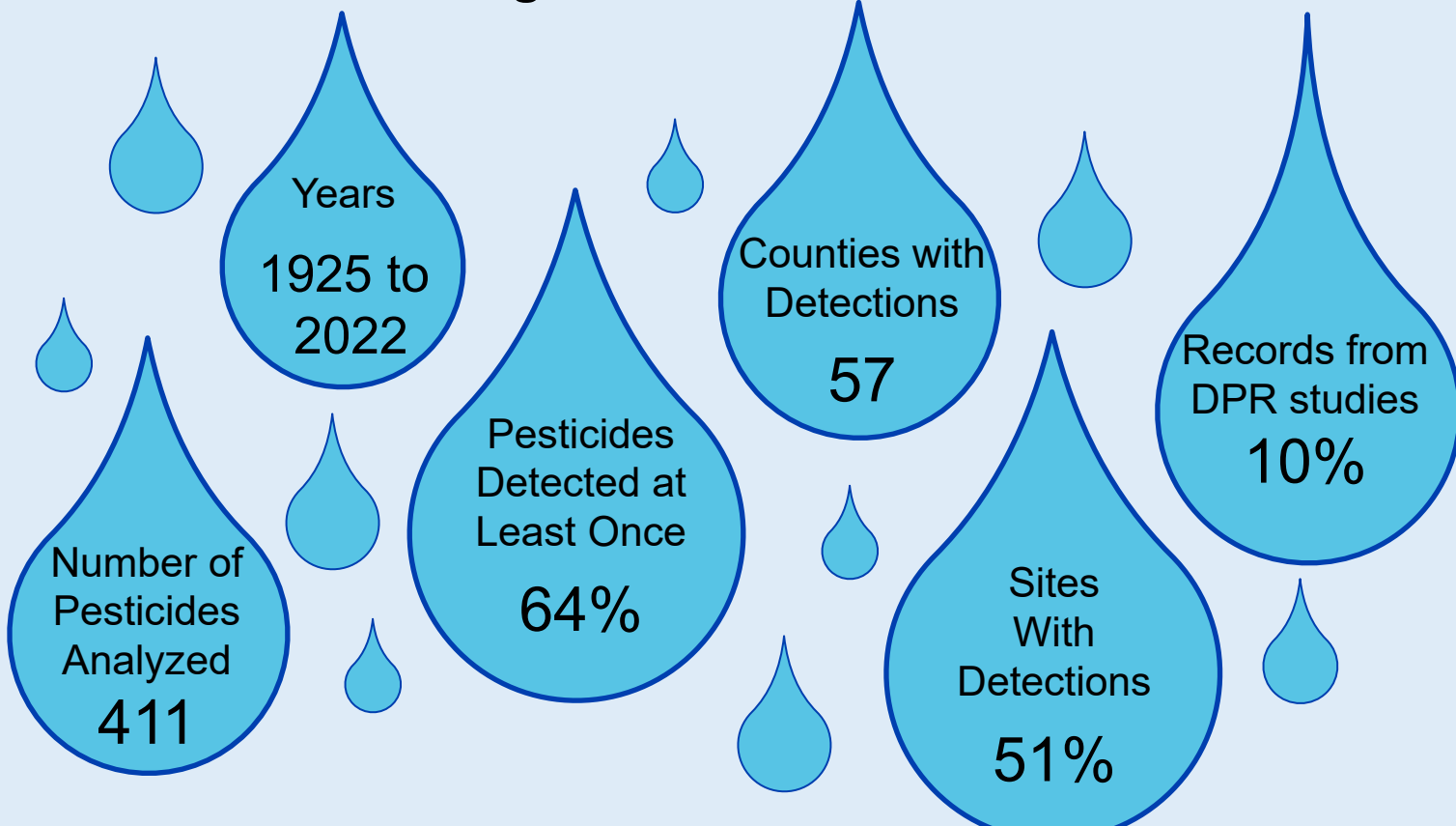

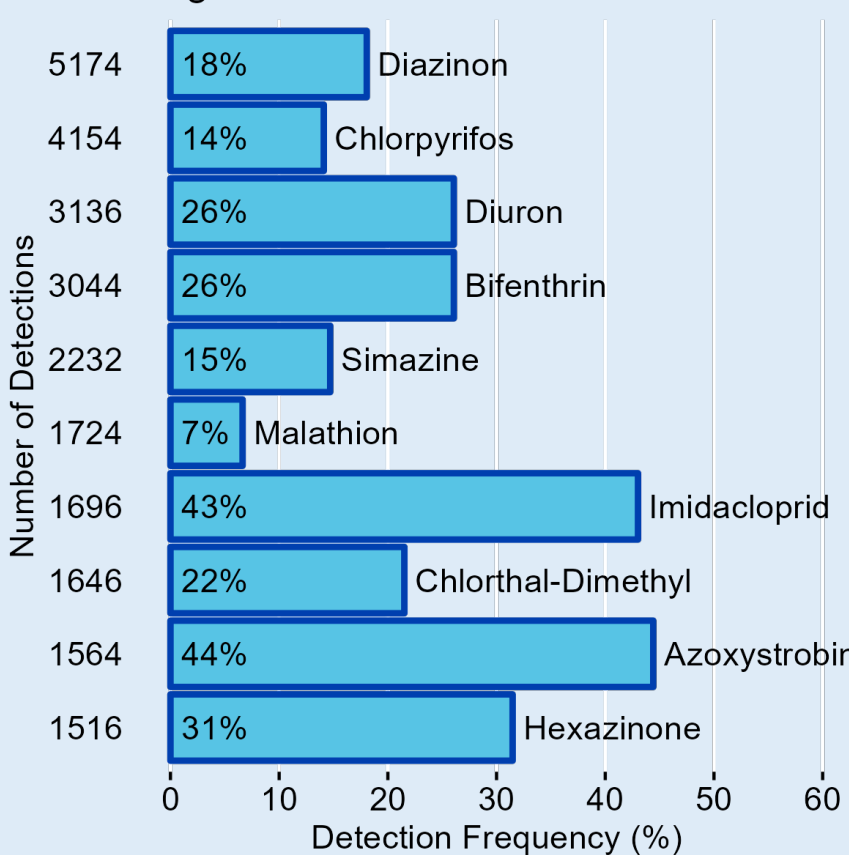
Location of SURF Sampling Sites



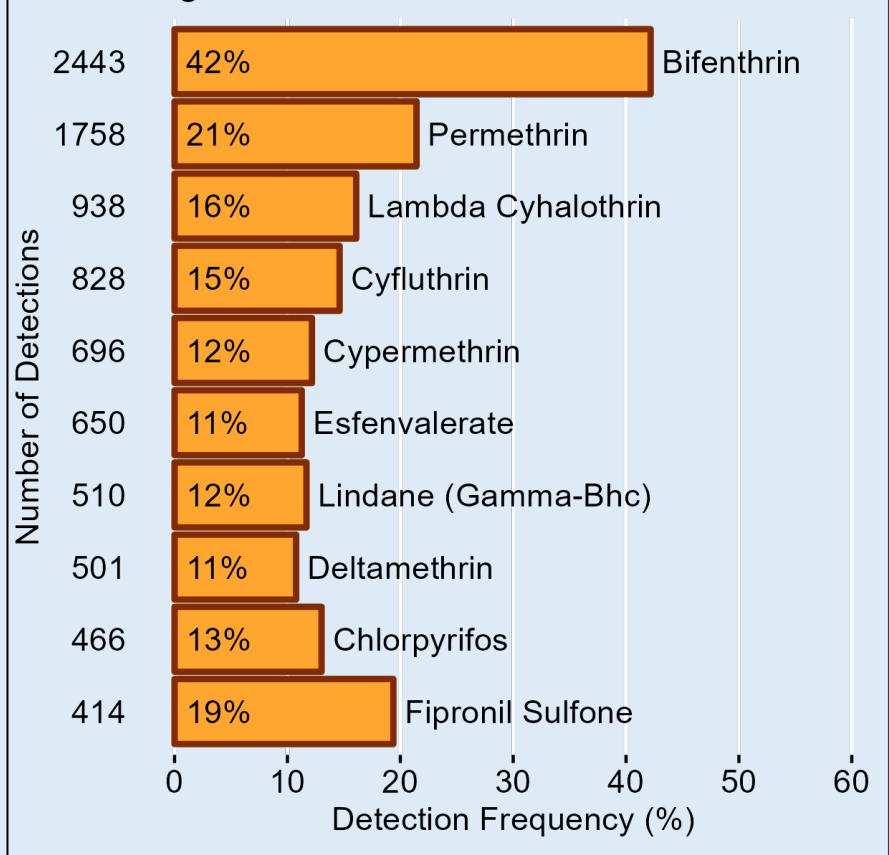
SURF Facts Including Both DPR And Non-DPR Data
