## TO: Pesticide Registrants and Other Stakeholders

# SUBJECT: PESTICIDE REGISTRATION BRANCH ANNUAL PROCESSING TIMEFRAMES

The Department of Pesticide Regulation (DPR) Pesticide Registration Branch (PRB) is responsible for the pesticide registration process. To fulfill DPR's mission of protecting human health and the environment, PRB processes and reviews all submitted application forms, data, labels, and other documentation, as well as coordination of the scientific data evaluation process within DPR.

As part of the process, product submissions are required to undergo multiple review steps. This process includes the coordination of scientific data evaluation by other DPR branches. All new and amended pesticide products must go through the registration process before they may be sold, distributed, or used in California. PRB staff work to complete submission reviews in a timely manner.

To improve transparency for stakeholders, PRB plans to annually report the number of submissions received and review timeframes for completed registration actions. This information will be issued in a California Notice posted on DPR's Web site. The information will include, for the past year and over the last five years, the number of pesticide product registration and amendment submissions received, including new active ingredients, and the average number of days to complete the same types of submissions.

Below is a summary of DPR's submissions and review timeframes for 2021, as compared to the previous 5 year averages (2016-2020).
