



Managing Conducive Conditions for Termite Infestations



Moisture

Termites are attracted to moisture. Reduce moisture in and around structures to avoid attracting termites.



Water Leaks

Repair irrigation or pipe leaks in and around the structure.



Mulch

Keep mulch at least a foot away from structures.



Vegetation

Trim vegetation at least 18 inches away from the structure.

Grade Slope

Make sure that water is draining away from the building.

Other Conditions

Termites are attracted to decaying wood and soil to wood contact. Cracks and gaps in screens, vents, or in the building's foundation can give termites access to the wood inside.



Tree Stumps

Remove decaying tree stumps that are close to structures.



Wood Pile

Clear piles of wood or plant debris away from structures.



Access Points

Seal gaps in screens, vents, or in the building's foundation.
