A. **Application Type:** Check the appropriate box(es).

New Journeyman Pilot Certificate applicants **must** have: a) been licensed as an Apprentice and have worked under a Journeyman for a minimum of one (1) year, **and** b) completed a minimum of 150 hours of operation of a fixed-wing aircraft or 50 hours of a non-fixed wing aircraft within the past two (2) years. Submit a completed and signed (by the Journeyman Pilot Certificate holder) "Pest Control Aircraft Pilot Statement of Supervision of Apprentice by Journeyman" form with your application.

• **Reexamination:** Scheduling an examination on which you failed to obtain a passing score or failed to appear for a previously scheduled examination.

- **New Apprentice Pilot, Manned or Unmanned, Certificate** applicants must successfully pass the Laws, Regulations, and Basic Principles Examination and the Apprentice Pilot Certificate Examination before the Apprentice Pilot Certificate is issued.
- **New Journeyman Pilot, Manned or Unmanned, Certificate** applicants must submit page three of the application demonstrating that they have been certified as an Apprentice and have worked under a Journeyman for a minimum of one (1) year, **and** completed a minimum of 150 hours of operation of a fixed-wing aircraft or 50 hours of a non-fixed wing aircraft within the past two (2) years. They must also successfully pass the Journeyman Pilot Certificate examination before the corresponding certificate is issued.
- **New Unmanned Vector Control Technician** applicants must submit copies of their Department of Public Health Vector Control Technician certification in Category B - Mosquito Control with their application and successfully pass a Pilot Certificate examination before the Vector Control Technician Pilot Certificate is issued.

C. **Examination - Laws, Regulations, and Basic Principles:** *This examination is required of all new Apprentice Pilot Certificate applicants.*

Exemptions: No fee or examination is required if you: (1) have a current Agricultural Pest Control Adviser License (PCA) or Qualified Applicator License (QAL) (to qualify for this exemption you must enter your current license number), OR (2) have passed this exam~~ination~~ within one (1) year. The Qualified Applicator Certificate and Pest Control Dealer's Designated Agent License do not meet the exemption requirements. Structural Pest Control Operators and out-of-state licenses or certificates also do not meet the exemption requirements.
